

CLARK COUNTY CLIMATE STAKEHOLDER ASSESSMENT SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS REPORT

I believe that many people want to be good stewards to the environment. Saying that, this report is a travesty. It is poorly researched and written. It highlights the high costs to the “forced” changes yet offers no solutions.

I have shared the document with each of you and have embedded comments using the Adobe Acrobat “note” function. I spent hours reading and annotating. You can click or “mouse over” to read my input. The comments and notes are extensive. There is literally insufficient time to address the myriad of flaws in this testimony.

A major point of concern is the use of the “equity” lens. Instead of equality the clear intent is to force changes and make adjustments for small groups that someone has decided have been or will be harmed and then putting special rules into play. That is not only inequitable but a recipe for disaster.

There is nothing that shows any planned efforts to reach out to the public and engage and educate. Everything is focused on “special interest” groups?

How much was the consultant paid? They did this in 2 months? That is a totally insufficient time frame for something of this magnitude. Their use of “snowballing” to conduct interviews is a fatal flaw. They solicit suggestions for future contacts from the initial. Those initial groups bias’ result in more bias. While it was easier for the consultant the outcomes are fatally flawed.

The “summary of input” is worthless.

I need to stop and ask you to find the time to read my comments in the document. I am deeply disappointed in the consultant and process and hope the Council will revisit the entire process and stop this nonsense.
