For 2 years, my colleagues and I have advocated in the legislature for the amendment to the Growth Management Act. I like to see staff start working on it as soon as possible.

As best as I can tell, according to the Public Participation Plan, the only group that forwards recommendations to the planning commission is the Community Advisory Group. And as best as I can tell, representatives of the fossil fuel industry are not on the Community Advisory Group. Good.

Please don't invite them to be on the Community Advisory Group. That would be a conflict of interests. They usually ask other groups to advocate for them, such as the Builders, the Steamfitters or LIUNA. They should not be on the CAG either.

The public participation plan includes "The Environment" as one of the **interest positions** to be included on the Community Advisory Group. The word "environment" is too broad. It includes garbage haulers, the spill response team and the Coast Guard. Consider narrowing that down to climate solutions, climate impacts, air quality and health.
