Dear Councilors,

Dr. Donald McIsaac was the main author of Alternative 4, which was adopted and then repealed, with the change in Council. Never, in the history of the Comprehensive Plan, has any incoming commission ever repealed policies adopted by the former commission. Proper respect for past policies were always shown. The information Dr. McIsaac used, came from overwhelming public comments, asking for a fourth Alternative that reflected citizen concerns. Hundreds of these testimony documents were not included in the public record for the 2016

Comp Plan update.

After Dr. McIsaac was satisfied that information in Alternative 4 was correct, he presented it to Councilor Madore, Councilor Mielke and Councilor Stewart to consider. Only Councilor Madore and Councilor Mielke showed any interest, and Councilor Madore took the lead to move it forward through a full public process. Attached are the professional credentials for Dr. McIsaac.
