The Clark County Council will conduct a work session on **Wednesday, January 17, 2023 at 9:00 a.m.** in the Councilors Hearing Room, sixth floor, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St., Vancouver, Wash. to consider additional work and review by the Technical Housing Code Forum on the following:

Housing code amendments related to middle housing and smaller single-family homes: Proposal to amend Clark County Code sections: 40.100.070-Definitions; 40.220.010-Urban Residential Districts; and 40.340.010- Parking, Loading and Circulation; and Clark County Code Chapters 40.260-Special Uses and Standards; and 40.520-Permits and Reviews. These proposed code amendments address short-term implementation strategies detailed in the adopted Housing Options Study and Action Plan (HOSAP) for smaller single-family detached homes and middle housing, including ADUs, duplexes, triplexes, quadplexes, townhouses and cottages in the existing low-density residential zones within the unincorporated Vancouver Urban Growth Area.

The work session will be held in a hybrid format with options to attend remotely or in-person. Additional meeting details and information on how to join remotely will be posted on the [County Council's meeting page](#). The work session is open to the public, however there will be no public comment as part of the event. Written comments from the public can be submitted to staff at any time.
