I'd like to give some feedback on two elements of last week's meeting: Draft Vision Statement and Community assets list

Regarding the Draft Vision Statement, here is the Draft as it was presented the other day with my suggestions in red:

20-years from now, we envision Clark County as a community where: • We all feel safe, included, and respected; • We meet our entire community's basic needs and all have access to healthy air to breathe, safe water to drink, healthy food options, affordable homes that keep us warm in the winter and cool in the summer; • We are collectively driving less and we are polluting less at home, work, school, and play, and when traveling in-between; • We are better prepared to cope with weather emergencies and uncertainties; • We are As good stewards of the land, we meet our entire community's basic needs and are and live within the limits of our environment. We have equal and easy access to open space, parks, locally grown food, accessible and sustainable transportation options, and our community's businesses and jobs are innvotative, adaptable and designed to make Clark County a better place for future generations to grow up and grow old. • Our quality of life is better and our entire community has easy access to parks and nature, recreation and health facilities, locally grown food, a wide range of convenient sustainable transportation options, and community places to convene, connect, and celebrate; • We are healthier physically, mentally, and emotionally; • Our community's businesses and jobs are innovative, adaptable, and sustainable; and • We are leaving Clark County a better place.

Food Production - should be a separate Sector and should have Asset Types that include large- and small-scale fresh food production, food safety, food distribution, waste management (return to land)
