In addition to the Comment Form we submitted, e add the following.

We live at the end of 269th Street to the West of the street. We are zoned 5 acres. Adjacent to our property is a creek that flows to Daybreak Park and the Lewis River. Property along the creek evidently cannot be developed and so the wildlife tend to migrate here. We have had beavers, deer, fox, coyotes, owls, bald eagles and golden eagles. This is less than two air miles from Daybreak School and the developing portion of the City of Battle Ground. Continued development in this direction forces the animals out of the protection areas and out of their habitat. Development should be encouraged in areas where this rich animal life is not already established.

Recently, the Heidleberg/Stordal mine across the road from Lewisville Park cut down ALL of the trees on the eastern edge of their property - which directly impacts the park's native cedar and hemlock trees. The summer sun setting in the west sets up a blazing heat on the park and its plants. Development should not be allowed to remove native trees which are well established in such areas.

Also - electric public transportation must be encouraged and implemented sooner than later.

We must preserve the beauty of our County lands in such a way as to compliment those spaces that have been in use - such as Ag use - for centuries.
