We overlooked defining the acronym since it was prominent in the last meeting's presentation of the greenhouse gas inventory. We are always working toward striking a balance between enough information so that the materials are understandable, and not providing a level of detail that is overwhelming.

In case there are additional abbreviations in the framework document that would be helpful to be defined, we've listed the definitions here:

HB – House Bill  
CAG – Community Advisory Group  
EJC – Environmental Justice Coalition  
GHG – greenhouse gas  
MT – Metric tons (1000 kilograms)  
ROI – return on investment
