I live immediately below the referenced parcels on Sunset Falls Rd with riverfront property. I am strongly opposed to adding a surface mining overlay to parcels 247859000, 247858000, 247860000, and 247849000. There are homes and timberland adjacent to these parcels. It would be detrimental to the people, homes, wildlife, and overall character of the adjacent area to have blasting and traffic connected to a mine on these parcels. Sunset Fall Road cannot support mining traffic.. These parcels have waterways on them that drain downhill directly into the East Fork Lewis River. Run-off from a mine on these parcels would flow downhill into the protected East Fork Lewis River. This area is not an appropriate place for a mine. Because of this, there should be no reason to grant a surface mining overlay for this land.
