Clark County Planning Commission,

This letter is being sent regarding the public hearing Item #2 for the November 21, 2024, meeting, to allow new cemeteries as a conditional use accessory to an existing church in the AG-20 zone.

With the growth we have had in Clark County there seems to be a shortage of cemeteries in the Rural Clark County area. Some churches are currently in the AG-20 zone. From a safety standpoint it would make sense to have a cemetery at the same site as a church building to eliminate the need to have funeral processions clogging up the roads. Also, most of the existing cemeteries do not have adequate parking spaces, which is a safety issue with people parking along two-lane roads with narrow shoulders.

We feel it would benefit Clark County to amend the code to allow cemeteries as a conditional use permit where a church exists in the AG-20 zone.

We are in full support of the planning Commission to approve the said amendment.
