I am writing to ask that you please listen to your COMMUNITY and NOT THE SPECIAL INTERESTS. Please pass Clark County RESOLUTION NO. 2025-04-xx AS IS, which would omit

options from the Comp Plan DEIS that would require the de-designation of resource lands or surface mining overlay designations, as well as discontinue the countywide resource lands study. Your staff has indicated there isn't time to do a proper lands study, so why are you trying to shoehorn one in?
