Comment

I'm asking you to keep Clark County on track to meet the Comp Plan deadline in December 2025. Please wait to study agricultural land until after the plan is submitted..

Delaying the plan means we also delay important housing and climate policies. We don't have time to waste. Cities like Yacolt, Camas, and Battle Ground have followed the process and should not be held back.

County staff have said many times that we will not meet the deadline if the agricultural land study is added now. Missing the deadline could cost the county valuable state grants and low-interest loans. These funds support important work and may not be available later.

Ridgefield and La Center are pushing to remove protections for farmland because of past planning mistakes. They have not built any new multifamily housing in two years. This is not fair to the rest of the county.

Please stay on schedule with the Comp Plan and delay the study of agricultural land until after December.
