Everything is happening at once.

The [Columbian Story](#) about Costco proposing to add 40 gas pumps at their Andreson location prompted this feed-back on FB.

1. Maybe the ideal place for apartment dwellers to charge is at Supermarkets, like Fred Meyers or Safeway Shopping Centers. People usually spend about 30 minutes in a store like Safeway, which is about the same time to recharge EVs from 20% full to 80% with a fast charger.
2. [Walmart](#) already has EA high speed chargers in at least 2 locations in Clark County but they are rolling out their own brand of tens of thousands of high- speed chargers in thousands of locations.

4. At least persuade Costco to install electrical conduit to future proof its facility.
