Clark County's own analysis shows that all projected growth can be met within current UGAs, there's no legal need to expand. The 519 acres requested by Ridgefield and La Center are prime farmlands essential for food security and climate resilience. With a climate emergency underway, protecting farmland is protecting our future.

The county is legally required to preserve ag land and meet the Comp Plan deadline to secure funding for housing, climate, parks, and more. I support adopting the Climate Advisory Group's full draft and Friends of Clark County's vision for a strong local ag economy.

The farmland study timeline lacks adequate public input. Ridgefield and La Center should not be rewarded for avoiding sustainable infill solutions. Councilors must uphold their commitments to a thriving, resilient community.

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
