For reference, here is a summary of the criteria: • The availability of public facilities, including roads used in transporting agricultural products; • Tax status, including whether lands are enrolled under the current use tax assessment under chapter 84.34 RCW; • The availability of public services; • Relationship or proximity to urban growth areas; • Land use settlement patterns and their compatibility with agricultural practices; • Tax status, including whether lands are enrolled under the current use tax assessment under agricultural resource lands; • Intensity of nearby land uses; • History of land development permits issued nearby; • Land values under alternative uses; and • Proximity to markets.
