We are local farmers and are writing to urge our council members to follow through with the completed Agricultural Land Study and KEEP land in Agricultural Use. Please do not DE-Designate any of our agricultural lands, in fact, our community needs more protection of our prime farm lands IN Agricultural Designation.

We know the value of our agricultural land first hand. We have farmed in Clark County for 8 years and our farm grows over 60 different crops; providing healthy food for hundreds of local residents, restaurants, markets and schools. Currently we are on leased land and have struggled to find any affordable land in Clark County that we could one day own. Many new and younger generation growers that want to own farmland struggle with high land prices to be able to purchase land. By helping to protect this land you make it possible for us to continue feeding our community and open up more opportunities for farmers to own and run farm businesses.

We graciously urge you to NOT de-designate any of our agricultural lands.
