Dear Sirs and Madams:

The recent agricultural land study implied that the majority (96%) of currently designated ag lands is farmable. Such a high percentage of productive land should be protected from any de-designation and should remain as ag land.

Therefore current ag land should retain its ag land designation and the Council should not proceed with any changes to these agricultural lands for site specific land designations.

Taking into consideration these clear results from the requested ag land study, the Council should recommend Alternative 1 (no action - retain current boundaries) in the DEIS options to meet the county's future needs.
