I am delighted to inform you that your barn and associated agricultural buildings have been listed to the Washington State Heritage Barn Register by the Washington State Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. The Washington State Heritage Barn Register is our state's official listing of historically significant barns and associated agricultural buildings.

Having a property listed in the Heritage Barn Register is an honor. Listing of a barn does not impose state restrictive covenants or easements, nor will it result in a taking. Listing in the Washington Heritage Barn Register does, however, assure protective review of a property should a state action have a potential adverse effect to the property's historic values. Since your barn is now listed, you are also eligible to apply for our grant assistance program when money is available. The creation of the Heritage Barn Register has generated a tremendous response from interested barn owners across the state. Since we began the program in 2007, nearly 800 barns have designated.
