We are writing from the perspective of 52 year residents of Clark County and the owners of 54 acres of active agricultural and timber land.

We support Alternative #1. We understand that all of the designated urban areas in the county have the capacity within their current boundaries to absorb the expected growth over the next two decades. I am most familiar with the La Center and Ridgefield requests to increase their urban boundaries and object strongly to these changes as they will heavily impact the overall quality of life and the economic viability of my farming neighbors.

The county is required by law to have enough agricultural land to sustain the local agricultural economy. Allowing further expansion of urban boundaries into the rich farmland will significantly compromise the county's compliance.
