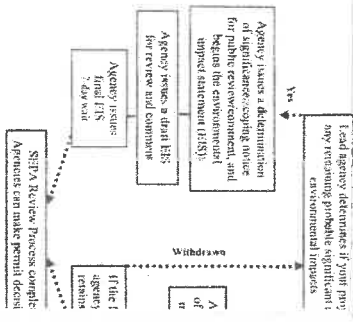

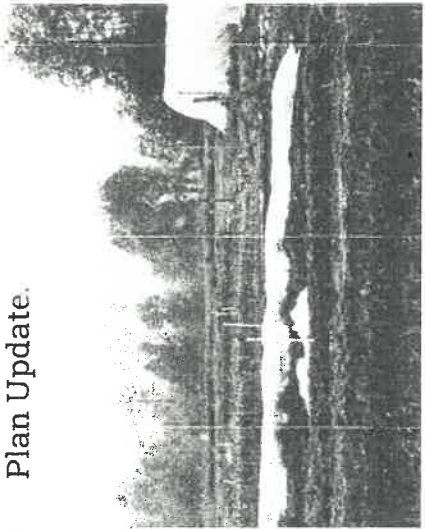

## What is an EIS?

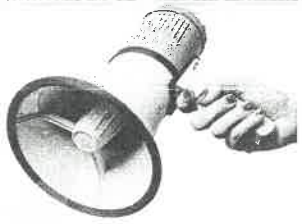
The Comp Plan is subject to the State Environmental Protection Act (SEPA) which requires assessment of multiple plan alternatives including a "no change" alternative in an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

## Comp Plan Alternative 1

The only alternative that does not expand Urban Growth Areas (UGAs), reducing unnecessary urban sprawl while protecting critical resource lands including valuable agricultural lands identified in the 2025 Agricultural Lands Study.

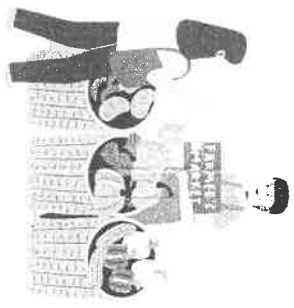
