Comments

I would like to offer thoughts on the comp plan.

Given the population growth data provided by the Department of Commerce and the housing and employment requirements, there is no need to expand urban growth areas (UGAs) in Clark County.

Clark County should not allow UGA expansion onto agricultural lands of long-term significance, as this is a violation of the Growth Management Act (GMA). There are other ways for us to grow responsibly and sustainably.
